## Examples of *documentaries* edited for Sky News

Title: Nelson Mandela: A Personal View  
Duration: 25 min  
Edited: October 2007  
Broadcast: January 2008  
Synopsis: As Nelson Mandela approaches his 90th birthday, Jeremy Thompson presents his personal memories of the man who's incarceration and freedom he has reported on for many years.

Title: The Queen at 80  
Duration: 45 min  
Edited: April 2006

Broadcast: April 2006  
Synopsis: Prince Andrew gives a tribute to his mother in this programme to mark her 80th birthday, taking Sky's Royal Correspondent Katharine Witty around the private apartments at Windsor Castle and also Buckingham Palace, telling stories about his mother and his childhood.

Title: Raider Nation  
Duration: 45 min  
Edited: February 2006  
Broadcast: March 2006  
Synopsis: Correspondent Peter Sharp spends several weeks with a platoon of US Marines stationed in Iraq.

Title: Harry at 21  
Duration: 25 min  
Edited: September 2005  
Broadcast: September 2005  
Other channels: Channel 5 (terrestrial)  
Synopsis: This was an important programme for Sky News. It was the first time that Sky News was "deemed worthy" to join the BBC and ITV in the rota for royal broadcasts. The formal TV interview has become a rite of passage for almost every prominent royal. Here it is Prince Harry's turn to face the camera, marking his 21st birthday with a frank discussion about his life and probably becoming the first royal to say "arse" in an interview.

### **Examples of *music promos* I worked on as editor & also director**

Title: *Phone In Sick Tomorrow, The Bazookas*

Synopsis: Of the indie-rock genre, this video follows the story of two girls who, watching The Bazookas on TV, decide to follow their advice - party all night and call in sick the next day. Obviously.

Client: Blood Shot Films, London  
Broadcast: CD-Rom only  
Synopsis: Shot partially in Turkey, the style of this promo for pop violinist Mee is abstract and minimalist.

Title: *No Defect, Inertia*  
Duration: 3 min  
Edited: September 2003  
Client: Blood Shot Films, London  
Broadcast: MTV Sweden and CD-Rom  
Synopsis: A fast and furious techno-goth music promo.

### **Examples of *series/shows* edited for Curious Picture**

Title: Bassiq  
Type: music show, 12 episodes  
Duration: 45 min / episode  
Edited: 2001  
Broadcast: South African Broadcasting Corporation (SABC3), 2001  
Synopsis: Billed as South Africa's funkier music show at the time.

Title: The Big Idea  
Type: science game show, 12 episodes  
Duration: 25 min / episode  
Edited: 2000  
Broadcast: South African Broadcasting Corporation (SABC2), 2000  
Synopsis: A science and technology game show that proved enormously successful with young audiences. It pitted teams of celebrity guests against each other and challenged them to build simple mechanisms with an unlikely assortment of materials - with both hilarious and instructive results. The Big Idea also profiled South African innovators and inventions including profiling traditional and indigenous technology.

Synopsis: The cyclical journey of a R10 note.

Type: episode, series and programme specific;  
themed (e.g. comedy hour)  
channel ID  
Genres: all genres of feature films, dramas, sit-coms, documentaries  
Duration: ~ 5 min  
Broadcast: South African Broadcasting Corporation (SABC3), 1999  
Award: Best Promo 1998/99 (awarded by the South African Guild of Editors)

### **Examples of work done as assistant editor**

Title: The Long Run  
Type: feature film  
When: 1999  
Release: Internationally distributed to cinema and video  
Notes: Assistant editor to Avril Beukes, one of South Africa's top editors, working with 35 mm film

Title: Dramatic Encounters  
Type: series of short films (shot on 35 mm)  
When: 1999  
Broadcast: South African Broadcasting Corporation (SABC3), 1999
